The fellowship chairman, the Alumni, and the Corresponding Secretary were directed to meet together and send out invitations to quests for the banquet.
6. Chapter Room Fund-Kooyoomjian  
A dispute has arisen as to what may be bought with chapter room funds.  
It was moved(Cheren) and seconded that the Finance Comm. be given the power as to determine what should be bought with money collected for the Chapter Room Fund. Motion defeated(3-5-1).  
  
It was moved(Mitchel) that the Chapter Room Fund be liquidated and all moneys returned to the brothers involved.  
At this time brother Nowill called for a quorum call. A quorum was not present.
7. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
