The motion that nominations and election of Corresponding Secretary be held at the next General Meeting was unanimously approved. Don Kawash was appointed interim Corr. Sec.

The brotherhood agreed to reimburse the drivers for expenses incurred on the trip to the Appalachian Mountain Lodge.

It was unanimously voted that The Critique be given \$25.00 from the General Fund to cover operating expenses this semester.
