## BROTHERHOOD MEETING Nov. 4, 1963

The meeting was called to order by the President, Bob Johnson, at \$\mathbb{Z}\$;10 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted. The Treasurer's Report followed. Kappa Omicron chapter has \$1160.80 in the 315 account and \$40.74 in the 315 ehecking BX account. Estimated expenses were \$1147.00 This was broken down into \$925 to the Art Aquisition Fund, \$200 to the Student Union for benches, and \$22 miscellaneous. Estimated balance is \$13.80 and \$40.74 in the checking account. Projected income for the chapter is \$120 for seat pads and \$100 plus for corsages.

Moved: Seat pads to be sold henceforth for \$1.25. Withdrawn. Amendment: Seat pads may be rented for \$1.25 with the return of \$1 when the seat pad is returned. This was defeated. Amendment: The change of the price of the seat pad to \$1. This also was withdrawn.

Moved: A committee be formed for the Corsage sale, with Dirk Lust and Joe Kielec being co-chairmen. There was no second to this motion.

Moved: that the date of APO dance be changed from February 1st to March 6 or March 13th. This was defeated.

There will be nominations for chapter offices on November 18th. Nominations will again be open on November 25th. The election of new officers will take place on December 2nd. On Bieember 9th, the brothers will vote on the pledges. The initiation of new brothers will take on December 13th.

The nominating Committee will be Jack Kooyoomjian, Don Kawash, Lorin Johnson, Dan Dwyer, Bob Morgan, Mark Cheren, and Bob Johnson.

There will be an off-campus party on November 23rd.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:18 P.M.
