and that there will be Christmas Caroling December 12 at 7:30 PM.


Motion: That any brother of Kappa Omicron chapter Alpha Phi Omega
or any sister of Alpha Theta Chapter Gamma Sigma Sigma shall have
a right to request for investigation of the procedures and accounts
of the Book Exchange Committee. The request for investigation
shall be submitted in writing to the Presidents of the respective
chapters and shall include the nature of, and reason(s) for said
request. The Presidents and first Vice presidents of both chapters
shall meet with the co-chairmen of BX to determine validity of said
request. Should an investigation be authorized, it shall be conducted
by a committee appointed by the two Presidents. At the close of the
investigation, written and verbal reports shall be submitted to a
joint meeting of the chapters.

of the co-chairmen of that committee. MSP.


There will be a joint meeting of APO and GSS 4 - 5 PM
