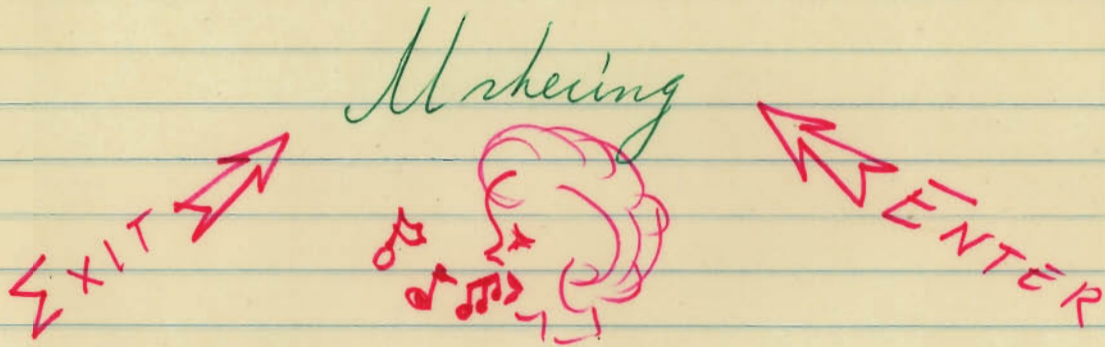
Laray Correia again contributed the most hours by adding 8 hours to the total.

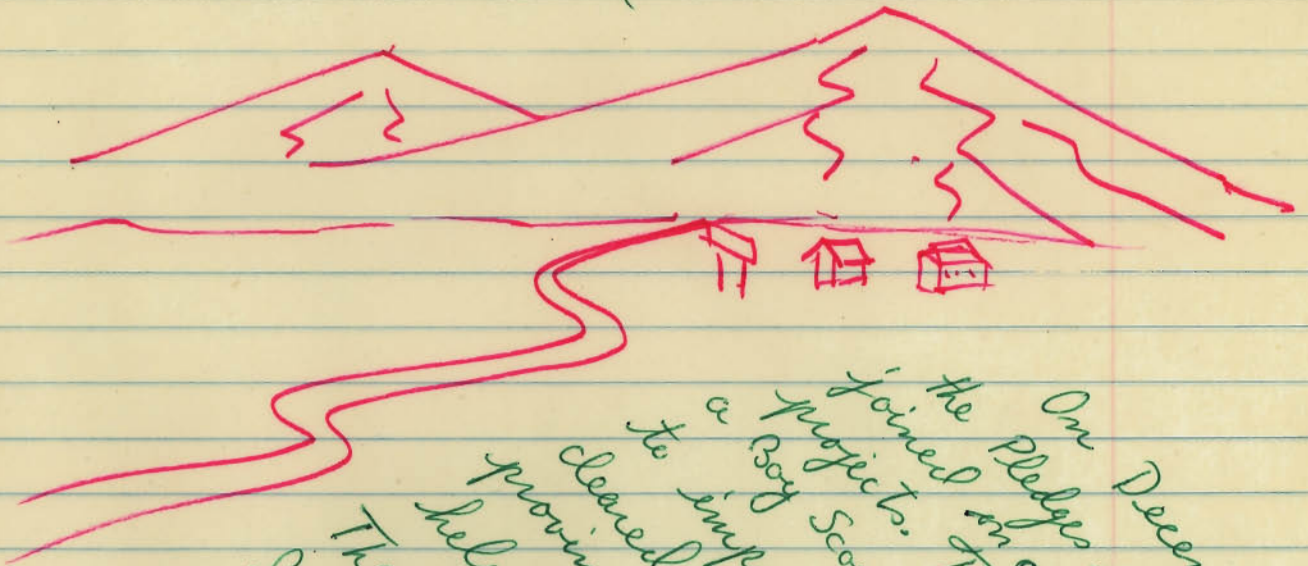
